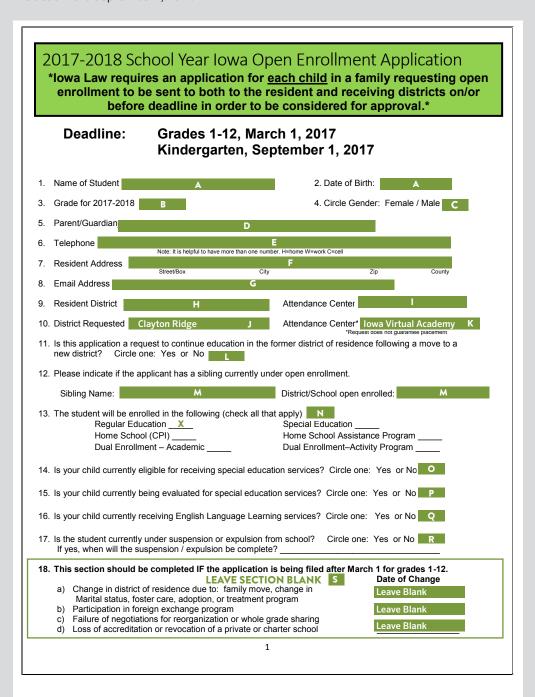
Completing the Iowa Department of Education's Open Enrollment Application

The deadline for filing an open enrollment application for the 2017–2018 school year is March 1, 2017. If the student will be entering school for the first time as a kindergartener, the deadline is September 1, 2017.





- A Include the name and date of birth of the student you wish to open enroll for the 2017-2018 school year. If you wish to open enroll more than one student, you must complete a separate application for each.
- Include the grade level your student will be entering for the 2017–2018 school year (not the current school year).
- Circle the appropriate gender for your student.
- Include the first and last name for the Parent/Legal Guardian of the student.
- Include the appropriate phone numbers for the Parent/Legal Guardian.

 Note: It's helpful to list more than one number.
- Include the address for the primary residence for the Parent/Legal Guardian and student.
- G Include the primary e-mail address for the parent/legal guardian.
- Include your current Resident School District.* A list of lowa school districts can be found on the lowa Department of Education's website, accessible via our enrollment page:

*The resident district is the district in which the student currently resides. If a student moves to a new resident school district at anytime during the year, a new open enrollment application must be completed.

- Include your current Attendance Center which is the school your student currently attends.

 Note: If you're enrolling a kindergartner or a current homeschooler, indicate the school they would attend if they were to enroll in their local brick-and-mortar school.
- Enter Clayton Ridge for the District Requested.
- K Enter **lowa Virtual Academy** for the Attendance Center.
- Circle YES or NO.

 Note: With the exception of students who moved out of Clayton Ridge Community School
 District, this box should be marked NO.
- If the student you wish to open enroll has a sibling currently under open enrollment, please include the name of the sibling and the district/school where he or she is open enrolled. Otherwise, leave this section blank.
- Place an X next to Regular Education. Families with children presently enrolled in special education should also check Special Education. Please DO NOT SELECT Home School (CPI), Home School Assistance Program, Dual Enrollment Academic, or Dual Enrollment Activity Program as they are not valid options for open enrollment in Iowa Virtual Academy. - Circle YES or NO to indicate whether your student is currently eligible to receive special education services.
- P Circle YES or NO to indicate whether your student is currently **being evaluated for** special education services.
- Q Circle YES or NO to indicate whether your student receives English Language Learning services.
- R Circle YES or NO to indicate whether your student is currently under suspension or expulsion from school. If YES, please indicate when the suspension/expulsion will be complete.
- **DO NOT** fill out this section as it only applies to applications received AFTER March 1, 2017.
